The following statements regard the rules of meem sakinah. Circle the 5 statements that are true (5 Marks)

1. There are only three rules of meem sakinah.
2. 'Iqlaab' is one of the rules of meem sakinah.
3. Similarly to the nun sakinah/tanween rules, the rules of meem sakinah depend on the following letter.
4. 'Iqlaab shafawee' literally defines turning over.
5. In 'Idhaar Shafawee', the meem will be written with a sukun over it.
6. Idghaam Shafawee applies to three letters.
7. 'Idghaam shafawee' literally defines merging and gives the effect of a shaddah.
8. 'Ikhfaa shafawee' literally defines hiding and occurs when meem sakinah is followed by the letter baa.
